





London's Green Cover




Areas of deficiency in access to public open space in London

Policy interventions

Green spaces and urban greening designed to hold storm water Green spaces and urban greening that support biodiversity Facilities for people to exercise, play and relax

Trees, green spaces, green roofs and and green walls to cool the city down



Targets

More than 50% green cover



10% increase in canopy cover



Benefits

Improved mental and physical health and well-being



A cooler city



Reduced flood risk and improved water quality



Higher biodiversity



Improved air quality and reduced exposure to air pollution
